Dublin Castle is situated in the very heart of Dublin City, on the south side of the River Liffey, off Dame Street, en route from Trinity College to Christchurch Cathedral.

Dublin Bus routes nos. 77, 77A, 56A and 49 from Eden Quay and no. 123 from O'Connell Street stop at Palace Street Gate. Proceed up Dame Street past City Hall to the Cork Hill Gate. Access is through the Cork Hill Gate (pedestrian and formal entrance) which is located beside City Hall, Dame Street. This entrance leads into the Upper Castle Yard - directly opposite The State Apartments. If you are staying in a hotel close to UCD, you are advised to take a taxi to Dublin Castle. There are no EAA bus transfers for the Early Bird Reception. A wine and finger food reception will be held from 8pm.
